

PROCESSION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT & BENEDICTION

After Communion the Blessed Sacrament is placed in the Monstrance on the Altar. The Blessed Sacrament is then carried in procession, reminding us that Jesus goes before us on our pilgrimage of faith. The following hymn is sung during the procession:

**Let all mortal flesh keep silence, and with fear and trembling stand;
Ponder nothing earthly-minded,
For with blessing in His hand,
Christ our God to earth descendeth, our full homage to demand.**

**King of kings, yet born of Mary, as of old on earth He stood,
Lord of lords, in human vesture,
In the body and the blood;
He will give to all the faithful His own self for heavenly food.**

**Rank on rank the host of heaven, spreads its vanguard on the way,
As the Light of light descendeth
From the realms of endless day,
That the powers of hell may vanish, as the darkness clears away.**

**At His feet the six-winged seraph, Cherubim with sleepless eye,
Veil their faces to the presence,
As with ceaseless voice they cry:
"Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia, Lord Most High!"**

After the procession all return to their places. After a short scripture reading, the following is sung: Please kneel.

**Therefore we, before Him bending, this great Sacrament revere;
Types and shadows have their ending, for the newer rite is here;
Faith, our outward sense befriending, Makes the inward vision clear.**

**Glory let us give and blessing to the Father and the Son,
Honour, thanks, and praise addressing, while eternal ages run;
Ever too His love confessing who from Both with Both is One. Amen.**

After a prayer, the Blessed Sacrament is raised in blessing over the people and the parish. After Benediction, the Sacrament is placed in the Tabernacle while the following is sung:

**Blessed and praised be Jesus Christ in the Most Holy Sacrament.
Hosanna, hosanna, hosanna in excelsis.**
