Today's readings The first reading is part of one of the Servant Songs in the prophecy of Isaiah which describe the one who is to come to save the Jewish people and, ultimately, all the people of God. As we read the prophecy we know that God sent his Son, the Servant *par excellence*, faithful and sinless though he was, to accept suffering and death in place of those who were guilty. The true epitome of humility and service.

The verses in the second reading, from the Letter to the Hebrews, follow on immediately from those we heard last week. Jesus is described as the 'supreme high priest'. Although he is God, because he was also human he had to experienced the same trials and sufferings that all human beings experience. He can therefore sympathize with our weaknesses. The writer then goes on to tell us that we can approach the throne of God without fear and with confidence, but we must also do so with humility.

In the Gospel today the brothers James and John ask Jesus to reserve for them the privileged seats on either side of him in heaven. Jesus challenges them with the question, "Can you drink the cup that I drink?" - in other words "Can you serve me faithfully until the end, whatever that may involve?" Jesus uses this opportunity to teach again about humility and service to others, and ends with giving himself as an example. "The Son of Man himself did not come to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many". True greatness, he says, the greatness for which his followers must strive, lies in willing service of others.
