Today's readings The first reading today is part of the second account of Creation in the book of Genesis. It begins with a brief statement which is fundamental to our understanding of God and of ourselves. 'It is not good that the man should be alone'. God created us to be in a loving relationship with him and with each other. That loving human relationship is expressed in its deepest form in marriage, which is blessed by God and is a binding commitment.

The second reading is the first of a series of readings from the letter to the Hebrews which will take us to the end of the Church's year. The (anonymous) writer of this great letter is telling us how Jesus Christ, the Son of God, came to earth to show us how to live, through humility and perseverance. In order that God's children might truly be saved, might really become sons of God destined for the life and glory of heaven, it was necessary that Christ should become truly man, and therefore experience death.

In the Gospel reading Jesus is being pulled into a trap by the strict observers of the Jewish Law. 'Is it against the law' they ask him 'for a man to divorce his wife?' Jesus reminds them that provision for divorce was not what God intended. God intended that marriage and family life should be the foundation of all human existence; and the more love that is put into a marriage, the more blessings will come from it.
