**Today's readings** We are told many times in the Scriptures that God needs messengers. That is what the readings for this Sunday are all about, and they tell us that this is a task laid upon us all.

The 1<sup>st</sup> reading tells how God calls Isaiah to be his prophet - probably one of the most familiar passages in the Old Testament, not least because Isaiah's experience is very dramatic. He sees an astonishing vision, and in words that are spoken he hears the voice of God. But the most important aspect of this encounter is not what he sees and hears but the way Isaiah responds: his five short and simple words: 'Here I am. Send me.'

St. Paul's conversion and calling to be God's messenger (his experience on the road to Damascus) was also very dramatic. In today's 2<sup>nd</sup> reading he tells how he has carried out the responsibilities God laid upon him then, but emphasises that the task he has been given is not his own (it is God-given); and is one he can only undertake because God enables him to do it.

Drama again in the Gospel as St Luke tells of the calling of the first disciples. They respond immediately, literally drop everything and follow Jesus. But then we hear how one of them, Peter, reacts. Aware that he is in the presence of someone who is very holy, he is also conscious of his own shortcomings. That may (probably will) be the same for any of us if we become aware of God calling us to do something. But Jesus's reply to Peter is our reassurance too: 'Do not be afraid'.
